glucose and blood pressure tests were done and medicines were distributed to all the beneficiaries at free of cost during the camp. The patients who needed further treatment were referred to SCMCH&RI.

NTEP Training for Lab Technicians



A training programme for laboratory technicians (LTs) of DoH&FW in two batches was organized by District Tuberculosis Office, Ramanagara in collaboration SCMCH & RI, Channapatna. LTs were being given training on microbiological examination (staining & reporting) of



Mycobacterium Tuberculosis, mainly on ZN staining. The objective of the training was to re-orient LTs towards correct staining procedure which will ensure better reporting of results. It was a 2- day training programme with orientation & briefing sessions conducted on Day 1, where the method of sample collection, smear preparation, staining & reporting of results were explained using AV aids. Hands-on demonstration of smear preparation & ZN staining procedure by LTs was done on the 2nd day.
